### III. **Student Disability Center- Alison Penfield; Terry Schliting**

- Moved to TILT
- Campus transportation options:
  - Van on campus
    - In 1990's for students with disabilities that need door to door service
    - Has morphed into something new
      - Students with injuries taking advantage of service
      - Not really equipped for this anymore; not experts in transportation
    - Thankful for around the horn; it helps keep students on normal transit services rather than using van
    - Does not serve students off campus
    - Work with about 1200 rides a semester
    - People rejected: every week people get denied sometimes several times
    - We have 1 van; ordered another electric car
    - Doesn't go to Foothills or VTH
    - at max capacity; would need a coordinator to expand; if we could partner with another entity on campus would help.
    - Possible solution: coordination through SDC; service would be done in partner with P&TS that has more expertise w/ transportation
    - Arizona State U has 5 carts radio controlled dispatch
      - ASU is 60,000 students
  - Transfort
  - Dial a ride
- Primary Needs:
  - Expand regular transit services to accommodate; micro transit
    - Students that need to go to the health center
    - UCA
  - Expand motor pool to have new van
  - Ramride could use accessible van so they are accessible to all students

- Means to help faculty, staff, and guests
- May be a better model to partner with P&TS with vans; having it housed in SDC is difficult.
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- Funding through SDC fee and general fund
- City Issues/ Transfort Issues:
  - Gap; application process is 4-5 week process; doesn't help injured students

#### **IV. Veterinary Medical Complex- Bob Kemphe**

- Want to see this as the South entrance of the main campus
- Vet Teaching System: the whole program
- Vet Medical Complex: geographic location
- Current:
  - Fed by Horn and MAX
- Plan:
  - includes 2nd and 3rd year students, so they would need to get to campus
  - want to include dog daycare to help students not have to go back and forth with long hours
  - need control access
  - Hotel on Drake in discussion
    - Could be a teaching opportunity for Hospitality students
  - New numeric address for all buildings
  - Offices, Labs, and Classes in this complex
- Transportation Needs:
  - More bicycle parking
  - Trails/loop near lagoon
    - South end trail
    - North stub from Mason Trail
  - Not great connection from MAX to campus
    - dark from trees; landscaping covers light
  - May need later night service on Horn

  - like Uber or Lyft but for carpool to connect people (WayToGo.org)
