  - iii. The current budget is about \$350,000 and the total cost for the projects is \$240,000
- e. Each college gave their opinions on each of the projects

- i. A common theme was largely agreement with the current rankings being Spoke, Pitkin bike roundabout, Rams Ride Right, SkiSU, and the covered bus shelters
- f. Motions were passed to make the rankings be Spoke at 1, Pitkin street bicycle roundabout at 2, Rams Ride Right at 3, SkiSU at 4, and Facilities- covered bus shelters at 5
- g. Should we fund SkiSU fully or fund them partially given that they will raise their ticket prices
  - i. Most members seem to think that SkiSU should be funded fully
  - ii. Mark asked if we should still ask them to raise their ticket prices
    - 1. That choice is up to them if we give them the full ask
